- To ensure continuity of care and with the goal to minimize disruption for students, HUB dug into the details of their self-funded plan to identify the best way to transition the plan to fully-insured.
- HUB's Data Analytics team digested self-funded data from LLU and provided critical reporting to conduct an extensive RFP. HUB received quotes from all carriers who write SHIP business in California.
- HUB negotiated quotes that would keep the plan benefit-rich while remaining affordable for students. Key plan terms like rate caps and performance guarantees were negotiated with the carriers to support the long-term health of the plan.
